Submission Deadline:

March 6, 2026

- Proposals are reviewed
- Implementation funding is awarded

What's your Solution?

- Come up with **one realistic solution** using democratic decision making
- Pitch your innovative idea to community leaders to gather feedback and ask for change
- Solutions are judged on innovation and adaptability, impact potential, research and writing, budget, visuals, realistic solution, environmental literacy, and connection to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)
